The Masters programme, lasting nine months, is designed for those who seek a deeper understanding of international criminal law and crime prevention instruments, as well as of the activities of international organizations and tribunals in this field. The programme provides in-depth knowledge and experience of both the theoretical and practical instruments for the prevention and prosecution of international and transnational crimes.

Taught by experts from nationally and internationally recognized academic and research institutions, as well as by practitioners from the UN system and special courts, the LL.M. curriculum offers students a truly unique insight into the activities and policies of both the United Nations System and international tribunals. In 2012-2013, the 40 UNICRI LL.M. students came from 26 different countries spanning all 5 continents and represented a heterogeneous range of academic backgrounds such as international relations, political science, criminology, and law. It is our sincere hope that the new edition of the course will attract a similarly diverse and capable student body.
