



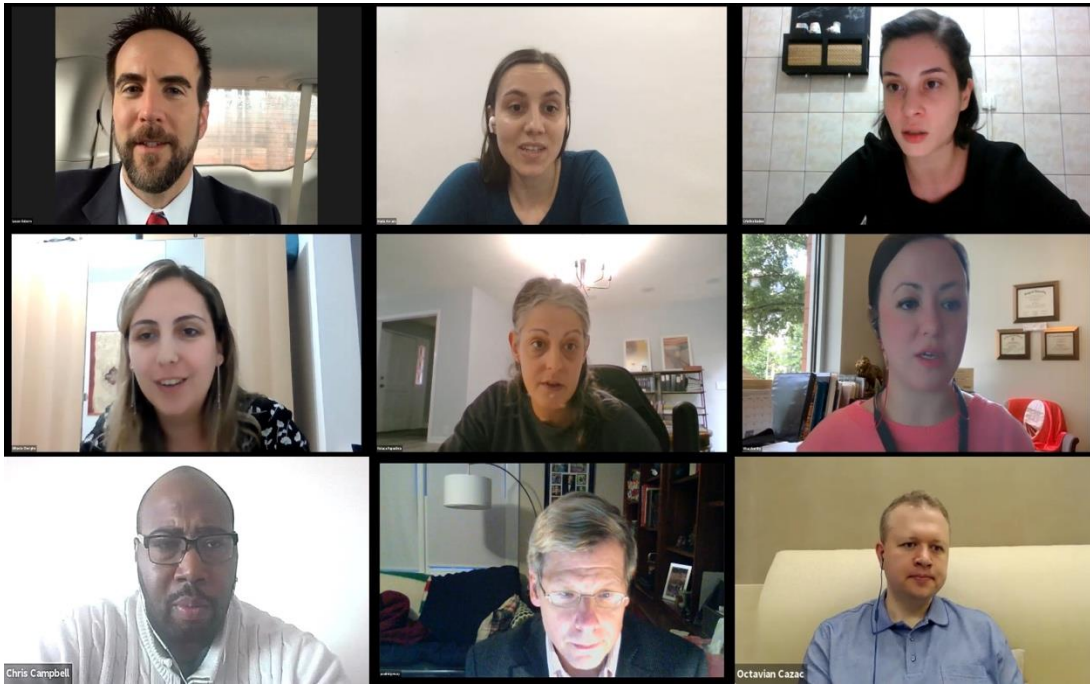
Results of the 8th (online) edition of the Bucharest Pre-Moot

The conference and the Bucharest Pre-Moot gathered virtually over 100 participants.

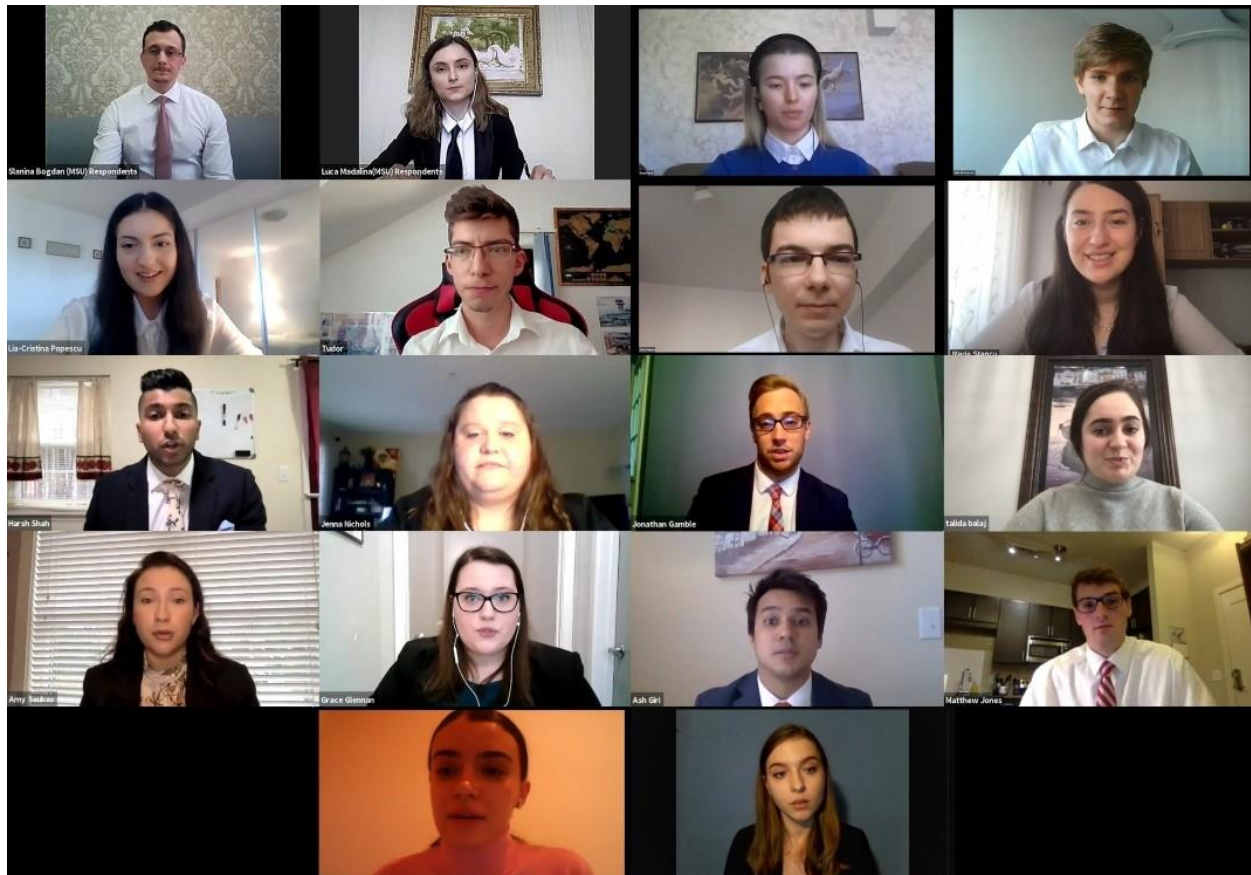

4 universities from 3 countries competed in the Bucharest Pre-Moot: Campbell University (USA), Charleston School of Law (USA), Moldova State University (Republic of Moldova), and University of Bucharest (Romania).

The University of Bucharest (Romania) won the award for the **best team**.



In the **best oralist** category, the award for **best individual counsel** went to Alexander Zupancic (Campbell University). The **best dual oralist award** went to Maria Stancu (University of Bucharest) with Ash Giri (Campbell University) in the second place. In the **best triple oralist** category, the first place went to Talida Balaj (Charleston School of Law), while the the second place went to Mădălina Luca (Moldova State University).
