Anca Pop is the Regional Intellectual Property Law Enforcement Coordinator for Central and Eastern Europe and Central Asia, with the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Overseas Prosecutorial Development, Assistance and Training and the Computer Crime and Intellectual Property Section, located in Bucharest, Romania. Anca is also a Federal Prosecutor, also known as an Assistant United States Attorney. She has served as an Assistant United States Attorney with the United States Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Michigan and the District of Arizona for nine years. In that capacity, Anca has prosecuted a wide variety of federal criminal cases, to include human smuggling, narcotics, guns and violent offenses, white collar, money laundering, intellectual property and computer crime, tried multiple jury trials and argued federal appeals. She also served as a judicial clerk for Chief Justice Stephen Markman at the Michigan Supreme Court and as a Prehearing Attorney for the Michigan Court of Appeals. Anca graduated from Babeş-Bolyai University College of Law in Romania in 2002. She received her second law degree summa cum laude from the Michigan State University College of Law in 2006. Anca has served on the board of various professional associations, such as the Women Lawyers Association of Michigan – Great Lakes Bay Region, the Federal Bar Association - Tucson Chapter, Bay City Morning Rotary Club, and several other local organizations and boards.
